Facilities Committee Update

- At the 12/4 meeting, the Facilities Committee voted to recommend that the BVCSD BOE move forward with plans to build a new centrally-located facility for all of our PreK-12th grade students.
- Superintendent is ready with an RFP for architectural services.
- Requesting that the BOE commission superintendent to move forward with RFP.



2020-21 Budget Development

- Tax Levy= \$7,291,850
- Anticipated Tax Cap = 1.7% = \$123,961
 - ~.7% (\$51,043)- BOCES Capital Project
 - ~1% (\$72,918)- Increase to BVCSD
- Output report -this week (actual state aid for 2019-20)
- Executive budget-January 15th
- \$13,000 from Assemblyman Stec

- NYSED 3-8 Testing- Scoring RFP



2020-21 Building Use Recommendation

- K-5 at Lake View Campus
- 6-12 at Mountain View
- Rationale:
 - Equitable class sizes
 - Curriculum alignment/Unified curriculum
 - More appropriate AIS Support
 - Equity for RTI, AIS opportunities
 - More elective opportunities
 - Accelerate math and science
 - Explore graduation pathways options (Increase advanced regents diplomas)
 - Reduce or eliminate travel between buildings for faculty/staff
 - Entire campus focused on K-5 (curriculum, SEL, Age-appropriate PBIS, schedule)
 - Reduce lost educational minutes for sports trips
 - Targeted Professional development
 - Allow for more focus of building principals and counselors
 - Cost savings through attrition
 - Maximize efficiency and opportunities

Displacing approximately 18 faculty members



2020-21 Building Use Recommendation

- Topic discussed starting in February 2019
- Current model decided on in April 2019
- Topic revisited with
 - Administration-November 2019
 - Teachers- December 2019
 - BOE- December 2019
- Recommended Timeline:
 - December and January- continue conversations and information gathering
 - January- Superintendent recommendation to the BOE
 - Until such time as all K-12 is in one building
- Recommendation will be based on what is educationally best for students.
- January-June: Planning and preparing
- June-August: Moving
- September: School Opening
