Early Bridges:

Early Bridges is providing instruction through a virtual classroom. Monday through Friday they are providing daily lessons in ELA, Math, Social Emotional Skills and Music & Movement. Social Studies, Science, Health & Nutrition, and Art lessons are provided weekly through project-based activities. For students that are not able to access the virtual classroom we are sending instructional packets that coincide with the lessons being provided in the virtual classroom. The Early Bridges teachers and family worker call homes once a week. Through these calls they are doing a wellness check and also providing instructional support and progress monitoring students learning.

Student Support Services Department:

Families have received communication from classroom teacher(s), Special Education Teacher/Case Manager, service providers and myself. Communication is being done weekly. School work is being provided by the teacher(s) through packets or via digital methods dependent on the students technological abilities. Case managers are providing the special education services through google classroom, google hangout meetings and phone calls. Service providers are also providing activities to complete for the students that they service. Most providers are integrating technology to do face to face teletherapy for those that have internet capabilities. Service providers include, OT, PT, Speech and Counseling. At this time all special education services are being provided according to students' documents. Annual review meetings have also been rescheduled and currently happening.
