



A virtual **Budget Hearing** will be held on **Tuesday, June 2, 2020** at 6:00 pm for a presentation of the proposed 2020-2021 Boquet Valley Central School District budget. In accordance with Governor Cuomo's Executive Order No. 202.1, the meeting will be conducted remotely via streaming video only, with no public in-person access.

The Boquet Valley Central School District **Budget Vote and Election** is scheduled for **Tuesday, June 9, 2020** - voting will be by ABSENTEE BALLOT only. Pursuant to Executive Order No. 202.26, all voting for the Budget Vote and Election will be done by absentee ballot such that the school district must send absentee ballots with a postage paid, return envelope to each "qualified voter". The deadline to return the absentee ballot is no later than 5:00 pm on June 9, 2020.

A qualified voter is someone who is a U.S. citizen, 18 years of age, a resident of the District for at least 30 days prior to the vote, and not disqualified by any reason set forth in NYS Election Law §5-106.

If you have not registered with the Essex County Board of Elections and you meet all qualifications to vote in the June 9 Budget Vote and Election, please contact the District Clerk Jana Atwell at jatwell@boquetvalleycsd.org or 518-962-8244 to request an absentee ballot.

Voters will be asked to vote by (absentee) ballot on the following items:

1. Budget - to adopt the proposed annual budget for the fiscal year 2020-2021
2. Board Members - to elect two members to the Board of Education for three year terms commencing July 1, 2020 and expiring on June 30, 2023.
3. Salt/Sand Spreader & Aluminum Trailer - to authorize use of up to \$6,300 of existing reserve funds to purchase these equipment items.
4. School Bus & Passenger Van - to authorize use of up to \$139,000 of existing reserve funds to purchase one 65 passenger school bus and one 7 passenger van.
