

Budget Vote and Election

A virtual **Budget Hearing** will be held on **Tuesday, June 2, 2020** at 6:00 pm for a presentation of the proposed 2020-2021 Boquet Valley Central School District budget. In accordance with Governor Cuomo's Executive Order No. 202.1, the meeting will be conducted remotely via streaming video only, with no public in-person access.

The Boquet Valley Central School District **Budget Vote and Election** is scheduled for **Tuesday**, **June 9**, **2020** - voting will be by <u>ABSENTEE BALLOT</u> only. Pursuant to Executive Order No. 202.26, all voting for the Budget Vote and Election will be done by absentee ballot such that the school district must send absentee ballots with a postage paid, return envelope to each "qualified voter". The deadline to return the absentee ballot is no later than 5:00 pm on June 9, 2020.

A qualified voter is someone who is a U.S. citizen, 18 years of age, a resident of the District for at least 30 days prior to the vote, and not disqualified by any reason set forth in NYS Election Law §5-106.

If you have not registered with the Essex County Board of Elections and you meet all qualifications to vote in the June 9 Budget Vote and Election, please contact the District Clerk Jana Atwell at jatwell@boquetvalleycsd.org or 518-962-8244 to request an absentee ballot.

Voters will be asked to vote by (absentee) ballot on the following items:

- 1. Budget to adopt the proposed annual budget for the fiscal year 2020-2021
- 2. Board Members to elect two members to the Board of Education for three year terms commencing July 1, 2020 and expiring onJune 30, 2023.
- 3. Salt/Sand Spreader & Aluminum Trailer to authorize use of up to \$6,300 of existing reserve funds to purchase these equipment items.
- 4. School Bus & Passenger Van to authorize use of up to \$139,000 of existing reserve funds to purchase one 65 passenger school bus and one 7 passenger van.
