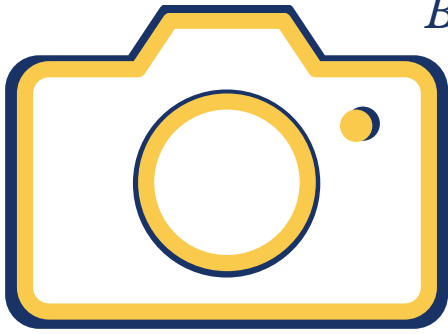

EVERYONE IS ENCOURAGED TO WEAR BLUE ON MONDAY 10/4 TO HELP STOMP OUT BULLYING!

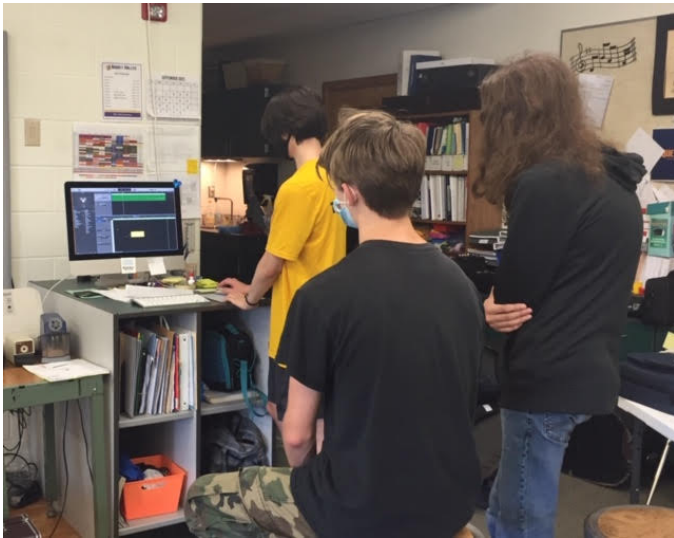

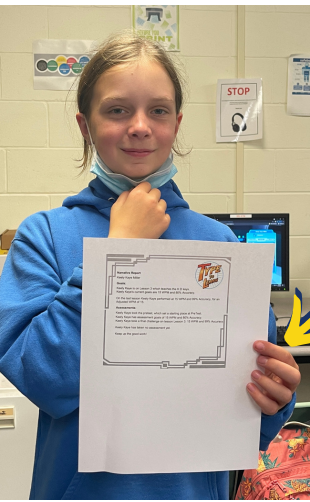

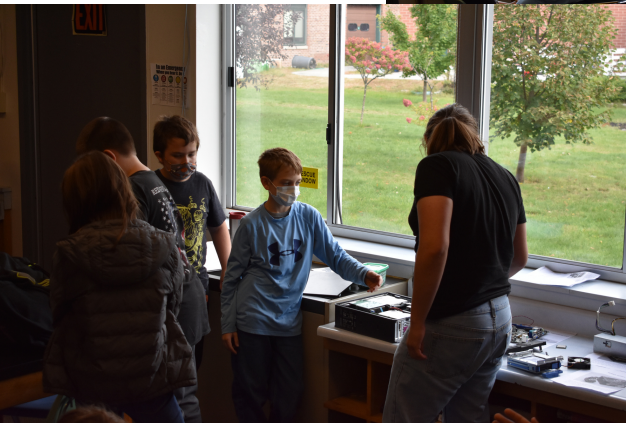

Hello All Consumers of Mental Health services and their families:

NEW YORK STATE IS WORKING TOWARD IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL "988 CRISIS HOTLINE" EFFECTIVE JULY 2022. ESSEX COUNTY HAS BEEN INVITED TO PARTNER WITH COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY AND NYS OMH TO CONDUCT RESEARCH TO UNDERSTAND STAKEHOLDER VIEWS ON CRISES, EMERGENCIES, AND WHEN TO USE 988 VERSUS 911. THIS IS A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY TO EXPLORE MORE FROM COMMUNITIES ACROSS NEW YORK ABOUT HOW THEY THINK ABOUT MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS AND THE TYPES OF SUPPORT THEY NEED, AS WELL AS ABOUT HOW THEY ANTICIPATE USING 988 VERSUS OTHER RESOURCES ONCE 988 IS ACTIVE. RESULTS WILL INFORM NYS OMH AND ITS 988 PLANNING COALITION ON DEVELOPING STRATEGIES TO EDUCATE THE PUBLIC ABOUT 988.

AS A VALUED ESSEX COUNTY CONSUMER OR FAMILY MEMBER OF A CONSUMER RECEIVING SERVICES, YOU ARE BEING INVITED TO PARTICIPATE TO SHARE YOUR VIEWS. THE RESEARCHERS ARE LOOKING FOR 8 PARTICIPANTS FOR THE FOCUS GROUP THAT WILL BE CONDUCTED OCTOBER 4 – OCTOBER 6 THROUGH VIDEO CONFERENCING. PARTICIPANTS WILL BE COMPENSATED \$50 FOR THEIR TIME.
