The students in Ms. Lackey's Architectural Drawing class have been busy constructing a greenhouse for the Science Department. The greenhouse was funded through a grant last year. Over the summer Mrs. Loher and Mrs. Fielder approached the Architecture Drawing class to construct the greenhouse so that the science classes can begin using it in the spring. The Architectural Drawing class meets every other day and have been racing the weather to get it enclosed before the snow flies. Almost there!



## Mr. Payne and Ms. Lackey Accompany 10th-12th Graders to Manufacturing Day at CCC IAM

Nine students across 10th-12th grades had the opportunity to attend the Manufacturing Day at Clinton Community College's Institute of Advanced Manufacturing. Thirteen local manufacturers were on site to discuss what they did, what type of jobs were available at their plant, what type of pay and benefits a new employee might expect to receive, what skills the students will need if they were considering a job at their plant, advancement opportunities and more. The students learned about the manufacturing of plastic bags with Salerno, train cars and VR welding with Alstom (formerly Bombardier), train doors/steps with Vapor Stone, PLC's with PlattCo, Arduino Boards and C programming with Professor Lawrence, torque with Snap on Tools, city buses with Nova Bus, tracks with Camso, wiring harnesses for transportation systems with AQ, road material and concrete with Upstone Materials, lightweight strong inventions with General Composites, medicine bottle lids with Mold-Rite and 3D printing.
