BUDGET RECAP

- Planning on a budget of \$15,167,449 (increase of 0.6% over 2019-20)
- ~\$7.6 million funded locally; ~7 million from state aid

LOCAL FUNDING

- ~\$7.6 million funded locally;
- We know about and have some control over local share
- Planning for a 4.15% increase to the tax levy (\$302,583)
- Potential impacts: budget vote

STATE FUNDING

- ~7 million from state aid
- We still do not have answers on state aid
- We have no control over state aid
- Planning for fully funded state aid
- Preparing for less than fully funded state aid
- Use any additional time that we have to continue to gather information and prepare to make decisions
- Potential impacts: look back period 1,2,&3; federal stimulus
- Remain hopeful that a federal stimulus can help to fully fund our state aid
- Prepare in the event that it doesn't materialize



Budget Priorities-How do we decide?

- 1) Reduce the academic impact to students.
- 2) Reduce the overall impact to students.

- Salaries and benefits are approximately 75% of our budget.
- Positions associated with salaries and benefits need to be considered.

TIERED REDUCTIONS

Each tier is an approximate \$100,000 reduction
