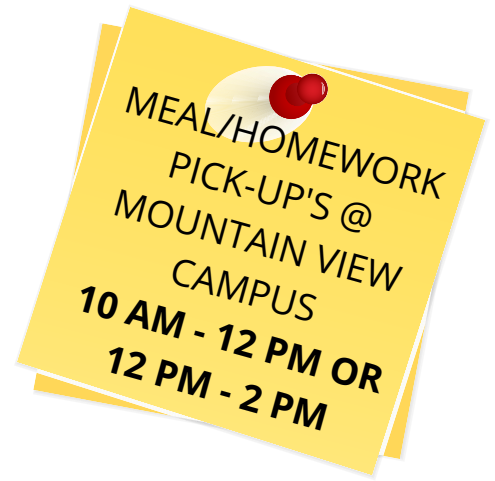
The Boquet Valley Parent-Teacher-Stakeholder Organization
