



## Lake View Campus, Reopening Plan:

### Drop off

Drop off will be in the loop for both busses and parents. Parents can begin drop off as early as 7:30. There is no supervision prior to 7:30.

Temperature checks will be completed as students enter the building.

**Auditorium** - Grades 2 and 3

**Cafeteria** - Grades 4 and 5

**Gymnasium** - Grades K and 1

### Food Policy

Students may not share food - this is especially true of any food brought from home. This currently includes any foods that may have been brought in as part of a celebration. Both Covid limitations and NYS Department of Health guidelines specifically prohibit the sharing of outside foods. We will provide updated guidance on school wide celebrations.

### Breakfast

Breakfast will be delivered to the locations.

**Hot Breakfast** - order day before

**Cold Breakfast/Snack Bag** will be available to all as a to go bag

Students eating will be seated 6 feet apart to social distance and eat

Students awaiting the school day and not eating will be seated away from those eating - social distancing should still be practiced and mask rules will be in effect.

Lunch request and next day breakfast request

### Lunch

Students will either be in the cafeteria or their classrooms. Lunch groups that are too large to fit into the cafeteria will rotate between the cafeteria and their classrooms. Lunch will be delivered to the locations. Students using the cafeteria will go through the lunch line.

### Recess

Recess will largely be held outside unless weather prevents students from being outside. If recess is inside it will be in the auditorium.

Students that are spaced apart from one another (12 feet) are able to remove their masks

Playground equipment will be limited in the number of students allowed on each piece of equipment. This will be decided for each piece of equipment separately.

The fence and cones will mark the area students are permitted to have access to

Supervisors will review the rules with students on the first day.

**General rules for recess include:**

- No throwing stones/wood chips
- Number of students allowed on each piece of equipment
- Areas students are allowed to go

**Hygiene**

Cleaning materials will be provided to each classroom

Students may only clean up their areas if we have signed permission from their parents

Hand sanitizer will be provided to classrooms and have locations in the hallways.

Hand washing is still the best option - Hand washing times before and after meals and traveling to specials should be scheduled into the day.

When in the halls students should keep at least an arm's length separation and wear their masks.

**Drills- We are still required to meet state expectations on the number of drills**

Fire Drills/Evacuation Drills

In the first week of school we will make an announced and planned sounding of the fire alarm so that students/faculty know what the fire alarm sounds like. We will not leave the rooms at this time.

We will conduct fire/evacuation drills one grade level or hallway at a time, these should be coordinated by the teachers with the principal. Each classroom will need to complete up to 8 of these by January.

Lock Down Drill - 4 required per year

In the second week of school we will make an announced and planned sounding of the Lock down Drill so that students/faculty know what the fire alarm sounds like. During this time you will demonstrate for students the proper procedure in your classroom and have students practice in small groups.

If we find ourselves in a real event. Covid-19 rules will not apply. Follow traditional processes to ensure safety.
