# COVID-19 UPDATE

- Essex County numbers: 62
- Clinton County (BOCES REGION): 92
- Regularly monitoring situation
- Finalizing our COVID Testing Plan
  - Only needed if we become a yellow zone
  - Test 20% of students and staff over 2 week period
- A closure will likely be the result of a staffing issue
  - Ticonderoga just announced a closure due to staffing
  - Saranac CSD cases
- Should we discuss going back to remote meetings?

- All policies have been completed by committee
- Superintendent is making the changes
- Should be on the agenda for approval in January



# PROGRESS ON DISTRICT GOALS

- District Goals have been accepted and approved by the BOE, but still in “Draft” form.
- We needed a place to start from.
- These will continue to be adjusted and modified and will have short-term and long-term aspects
- BVCSD has not been formally trained in a goal-setting process.
  - We have a process, but training has not occurred.

- To be the best rural school district in the state

Quarterly surveys have started. Feedback is being evaluated and improvements are being made.

- Exceed NYS standards.
- Incorporate Technology and prepare students for real world applications.

Programs are being explored by admins, committees and teams.
