

The FCC has opened the application for the **Emergency Broadband Benefit program which** will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute more than \$10 and less than \$50 toward the purchase price. This discount will be available until 6 months after the pandemic has ended, or until the money runs out. There are many households in New York that could benefit from this program.
