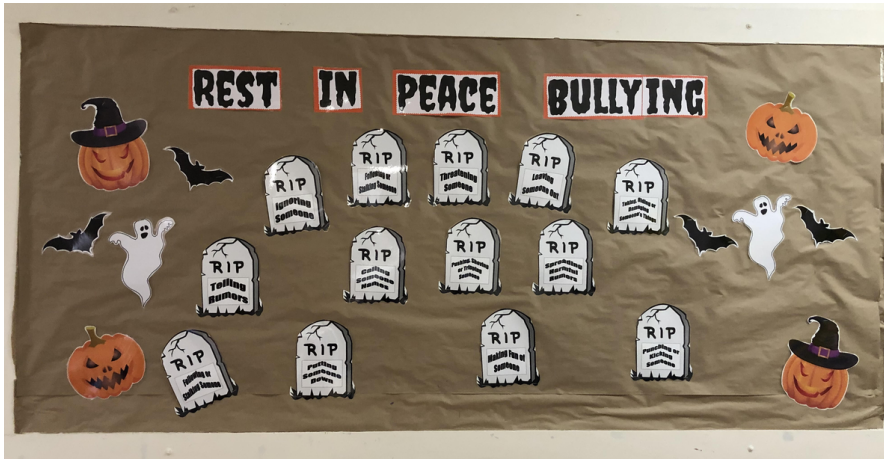

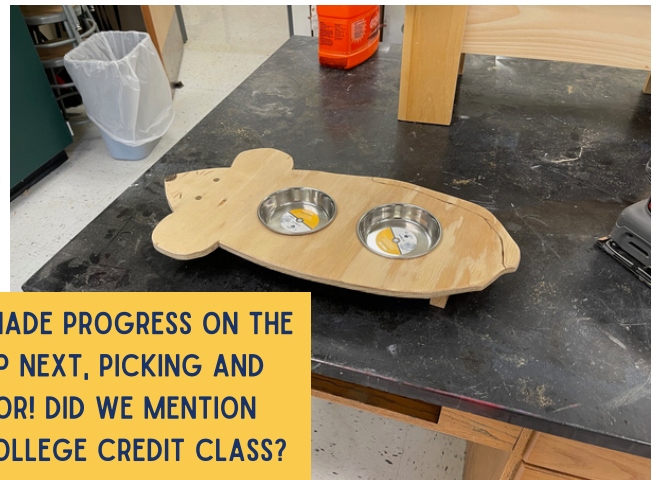

Boquet Valley Families:

As you are well aware, our district and many districts across our region, state, and country are having difficulty filling vacant bus driver positions. Boquet Valley has gotten by so far without any of our daily runs being significantly affected. Based on our current staffing levels and current needs, we have proactively started having conversations and developing plans to address a potential driver shortage for a morning run or an afternoon run. We remain hopeful that our drivers all remain healthy and able to work, but in the event that there is an issue and substitute drivers are not available, we will proceed as follows:

**MORNING BUS RUNS:**

If 5(All) buses are available → Normal morning bus procedure

If 4 buses are available → 4 bus runs will absorb the 5<sup>th</sup> route. This will cause some delays to the individual pick up times, but should get nearly everyone to school at or close to the normal time. (See specific details on next page)\*

If 3 or fewer buses are available → school will be closed with the potential for a remote option.

**AFTERNOON RUNS:**

Students will be divided among available buses and parents notified if the drop off time is affected.

If you or anyone you know would like to apply to be a bus driver for our district, please complete and submit the attached application. If you are available only in the mornings or only in the afternoons, if you are only available for one run per week, if you are only available for an occasional run, we could likely find a way to use you as a driver. Please contact me if you have any questions about becoming a driver for Boquet Valley Central School District. Our substitute bus driver positions pay \$21.00/hr.

\*Anticipated delays with only 4 morning buses covering 5 routes:

- Rabbit Bus- pick up 5 minutes earlier except for River Street
- Brookfield- no change to regular pick-ups
- Dolphin- no change to regular pick-ups; will add Water St and River St.
- Monkey- no change to regular pick-ups; will make additional pick up\*\*
- Kangaroo- no change to regular pick-ups; Lincoln Pond and New Russia will be picked up after regular drop off\*\*. Those students may be between 10-20 minutes late.
